Press the top left light to power on the television/projector

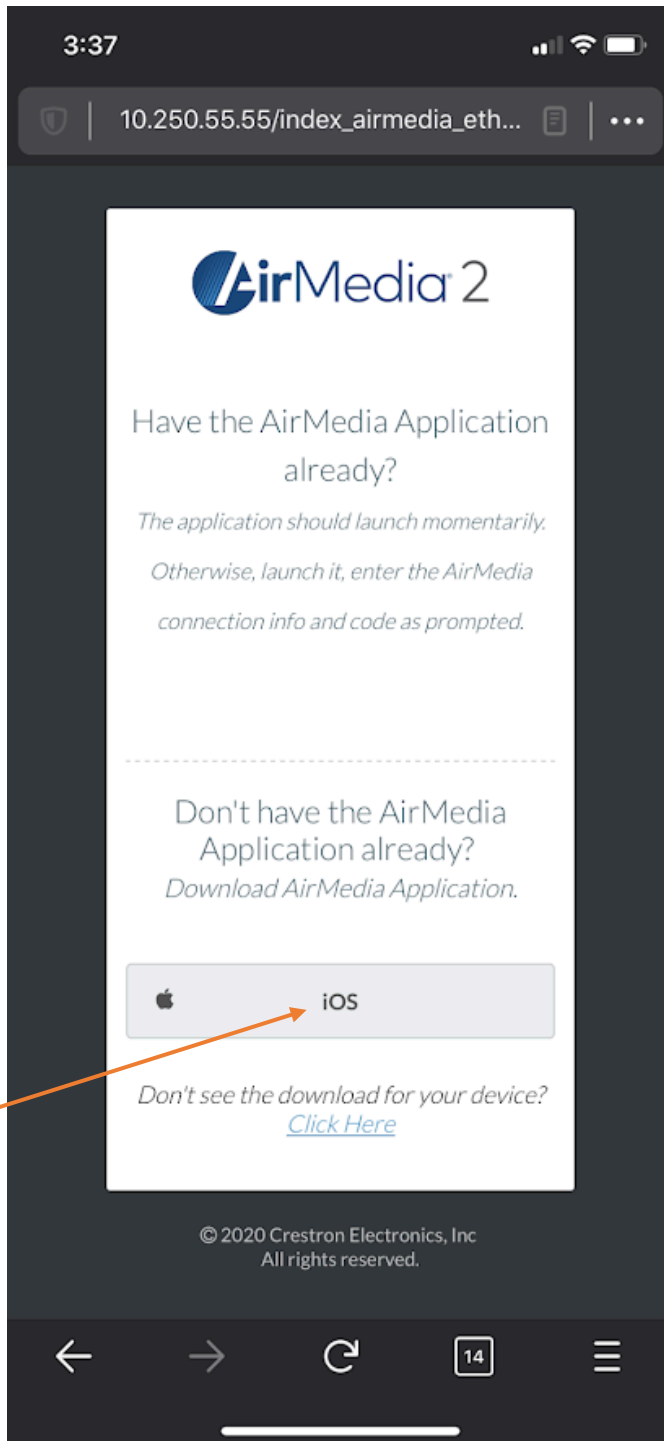
Open a web browser on your iOS device and type in the network address for the Crestron device



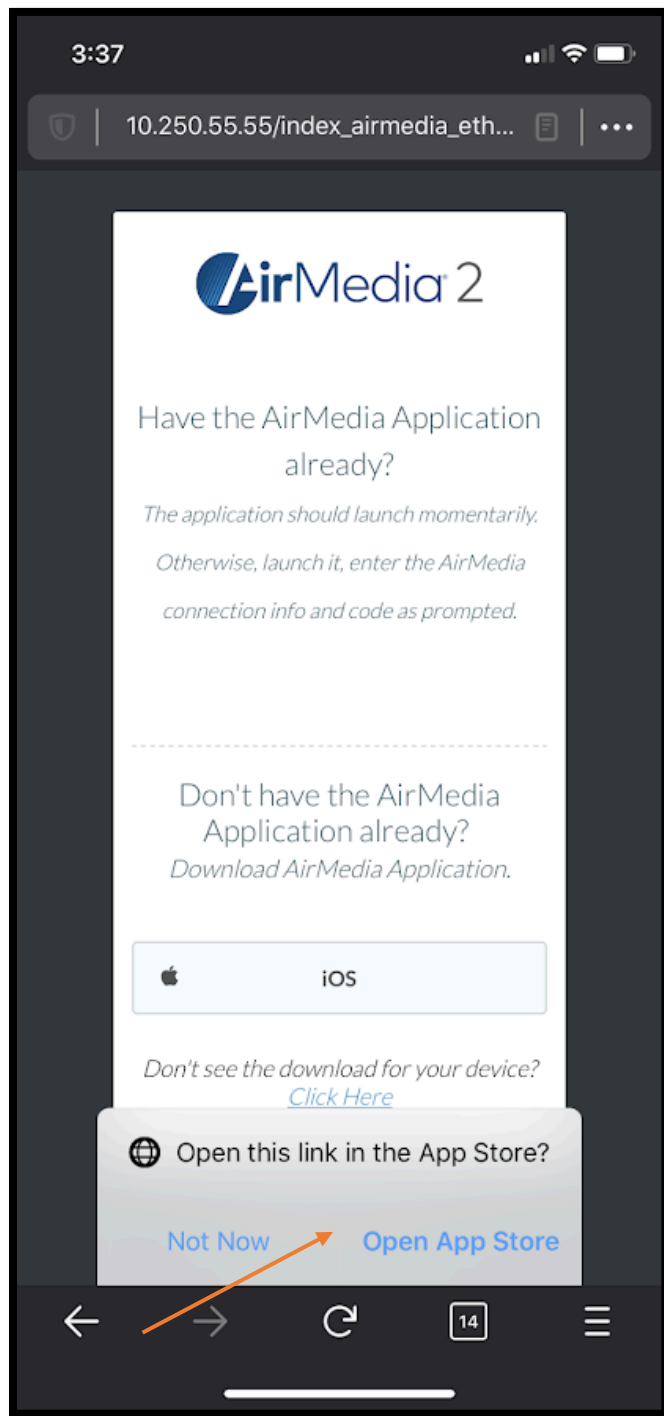
Click on “Start Presenting”



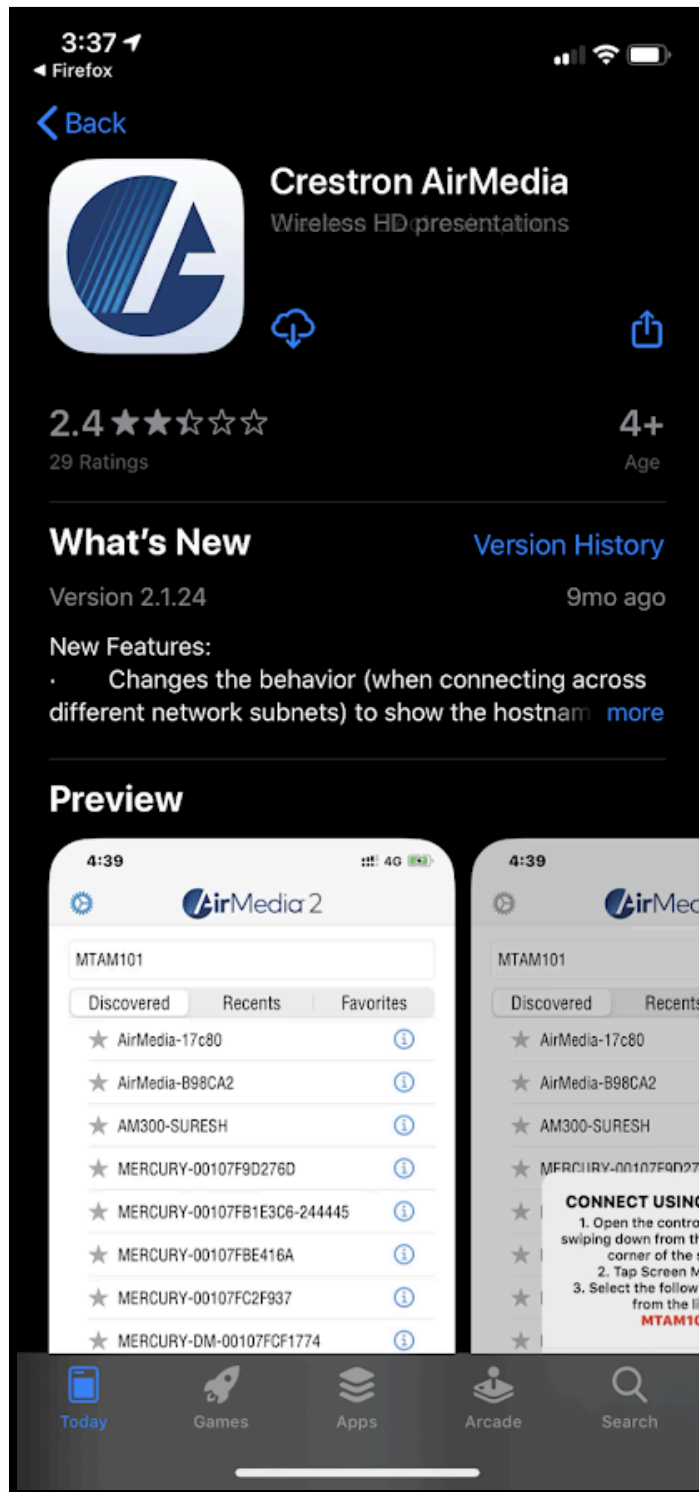
Click on "iOS"



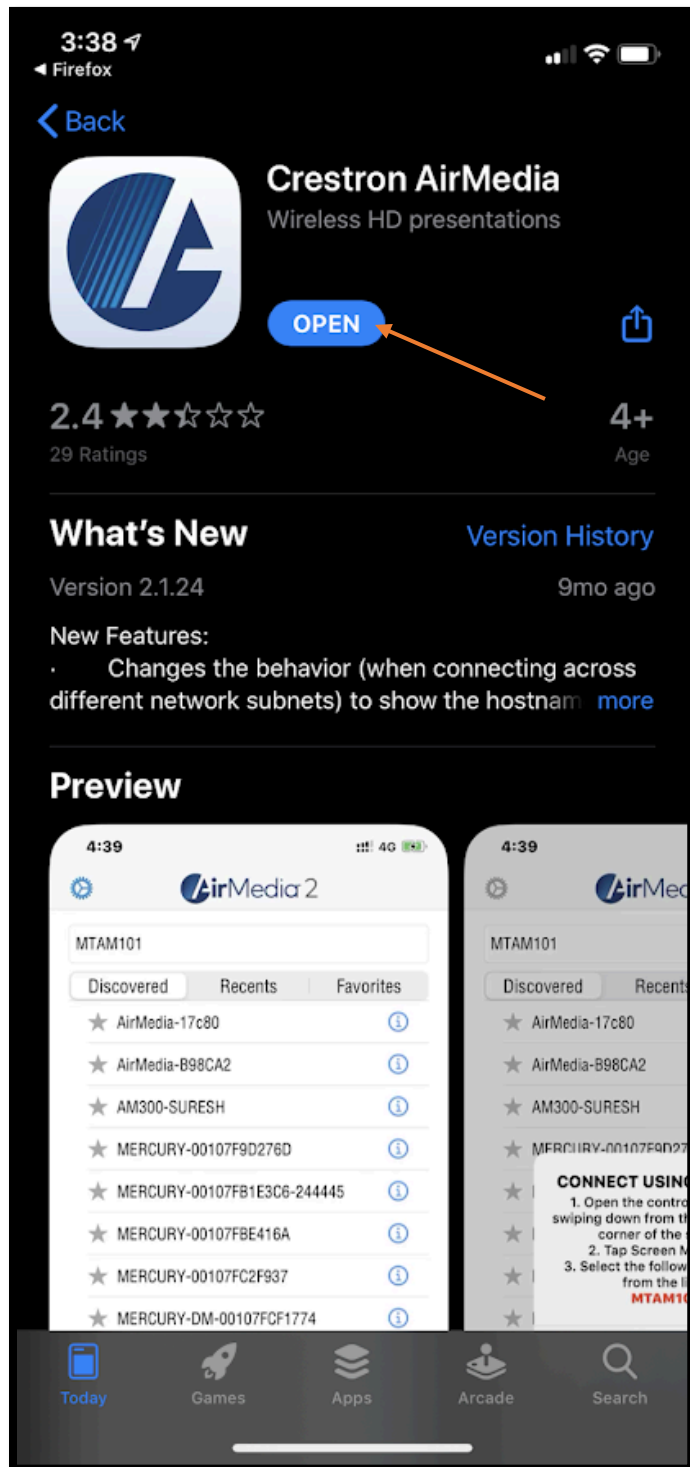
Choose "Open App Store"



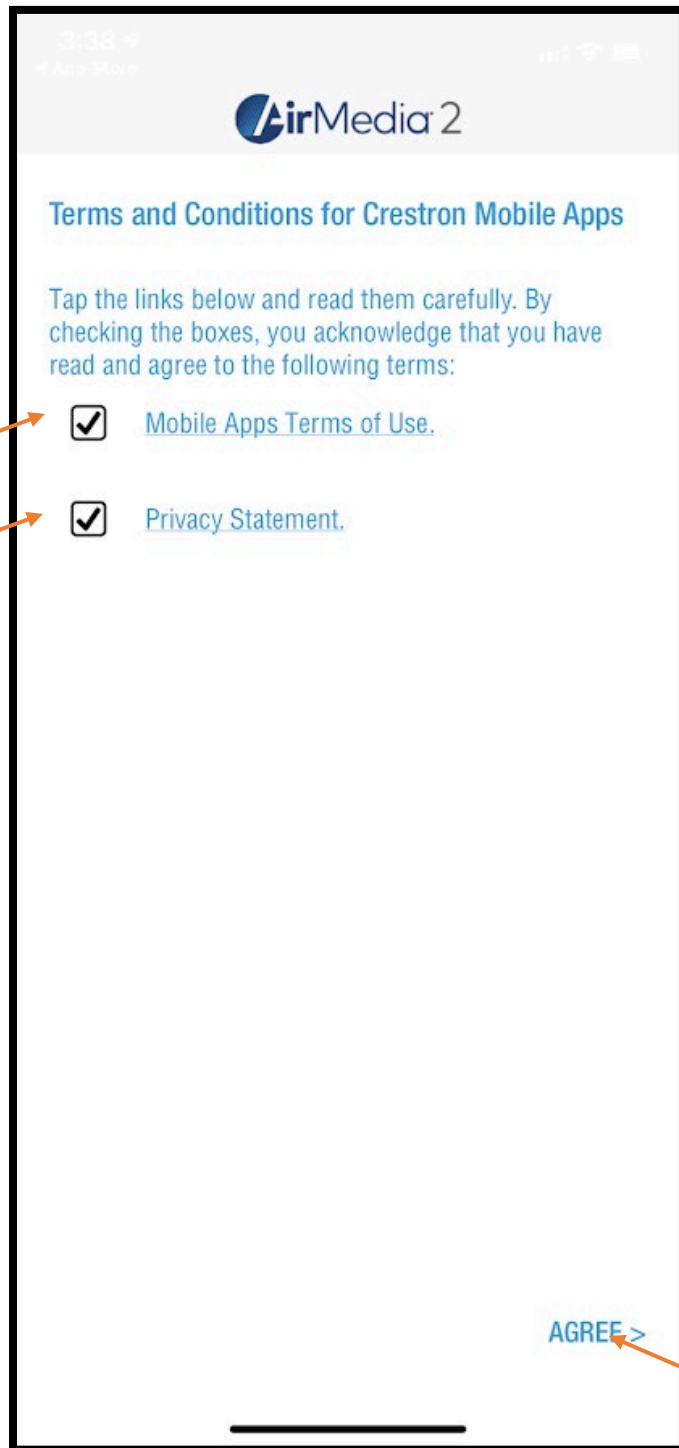
Choose "Install" and the App will begin downloading



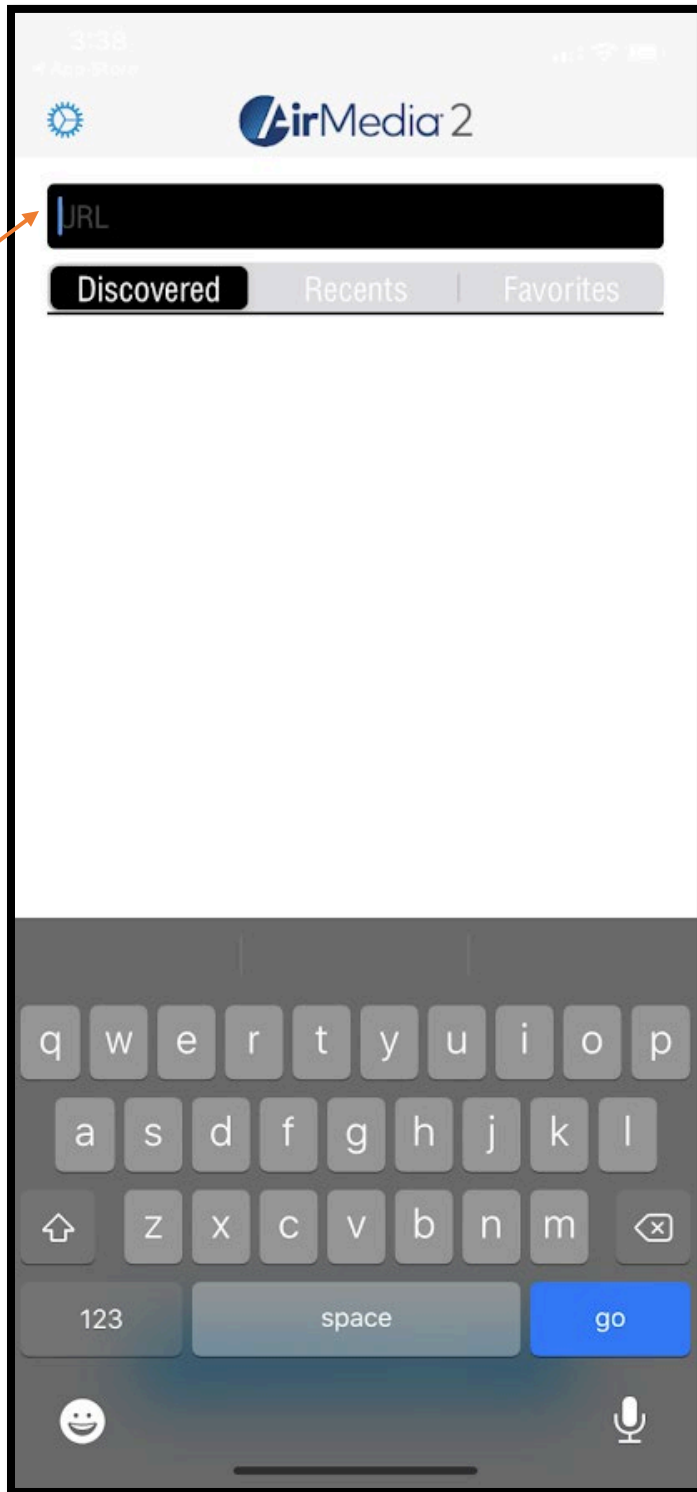
Choose "Open" once the app installation has completed

With the app now open, type in the IP address shown on the projector/tv display



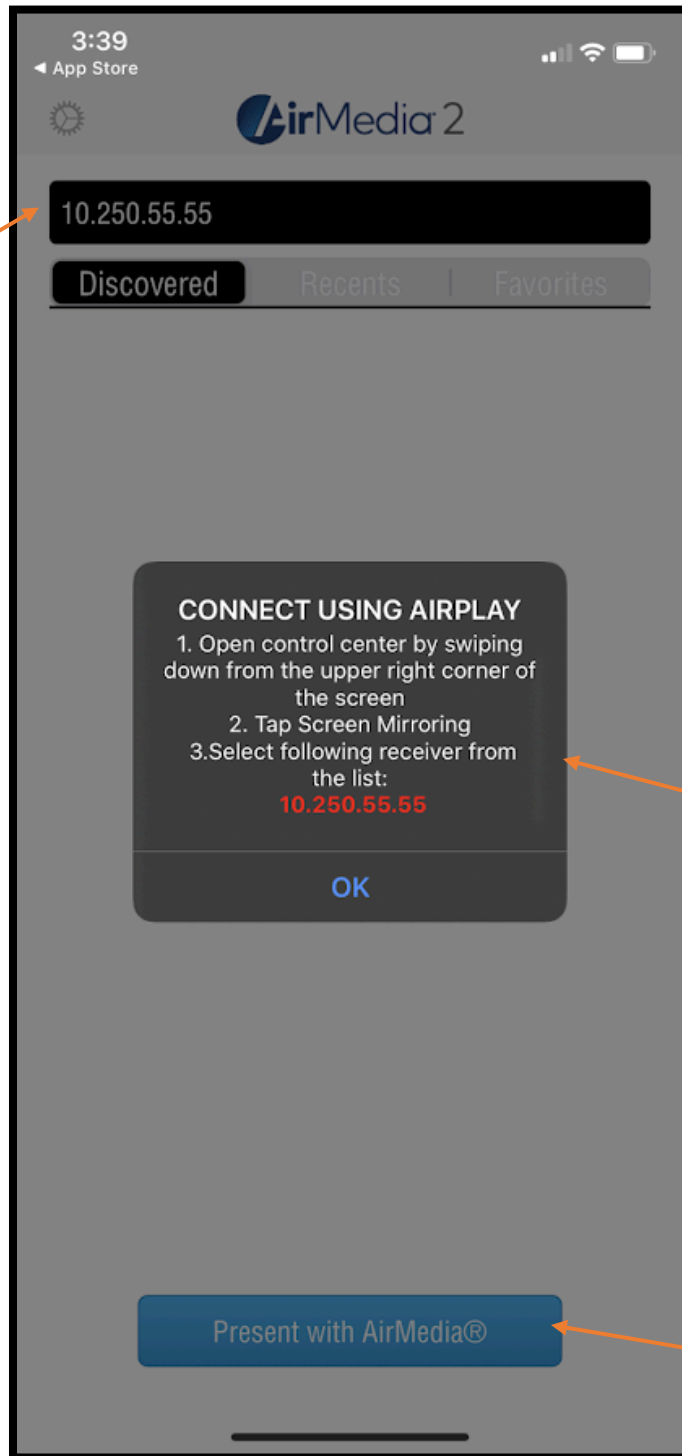

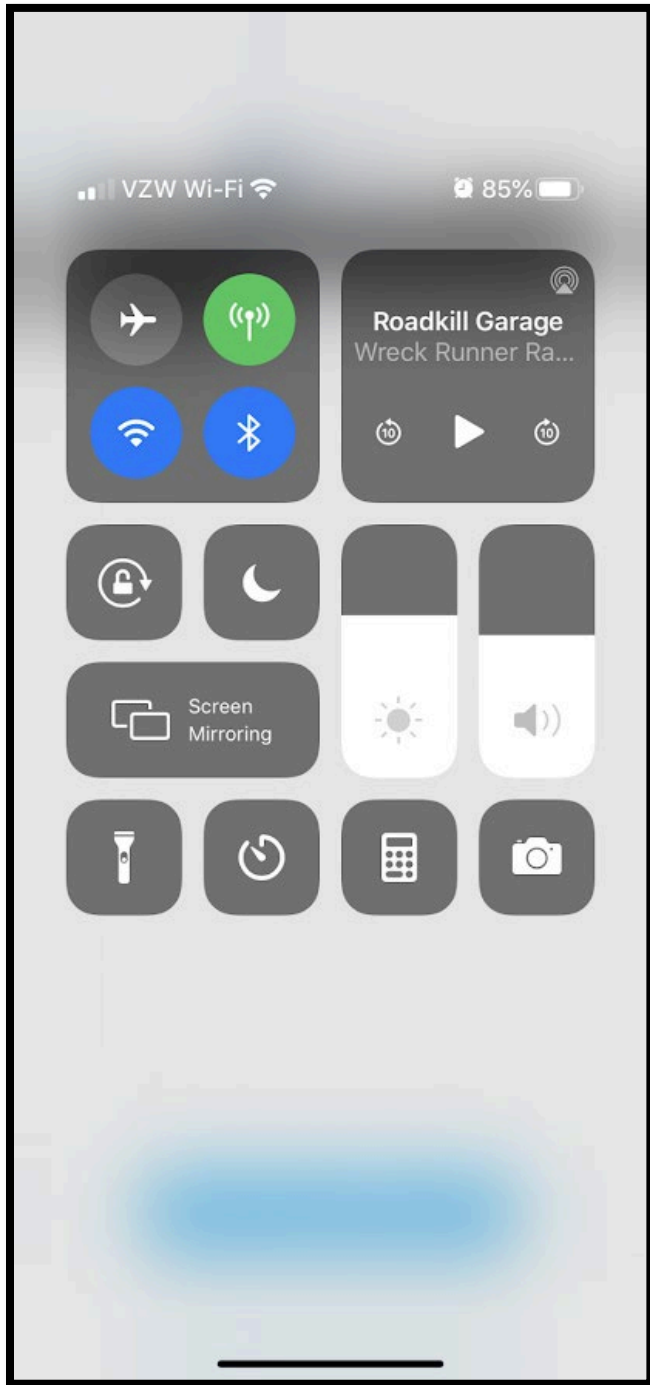

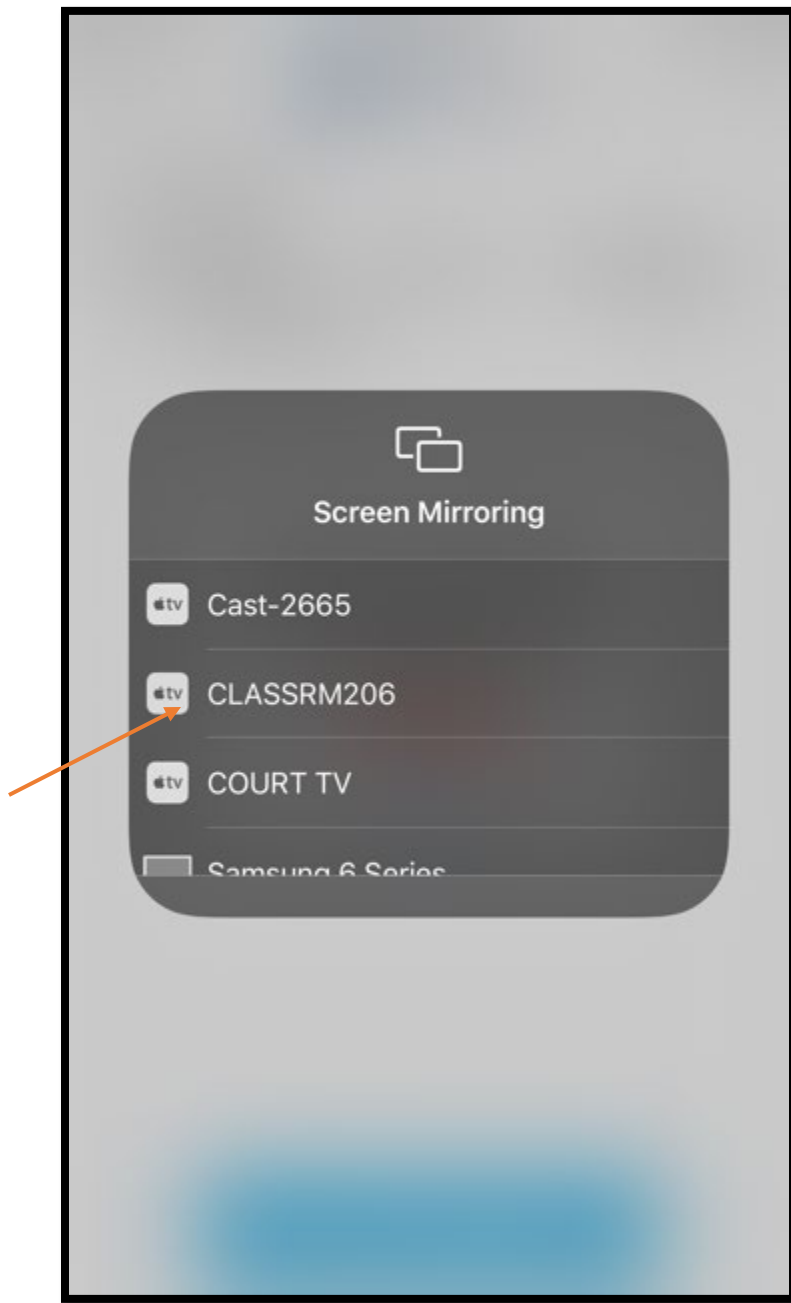
Click “Present with AirMedia” and you will be directed to open Airplay on your iOS device. Follow the instructions present to open Airplay.



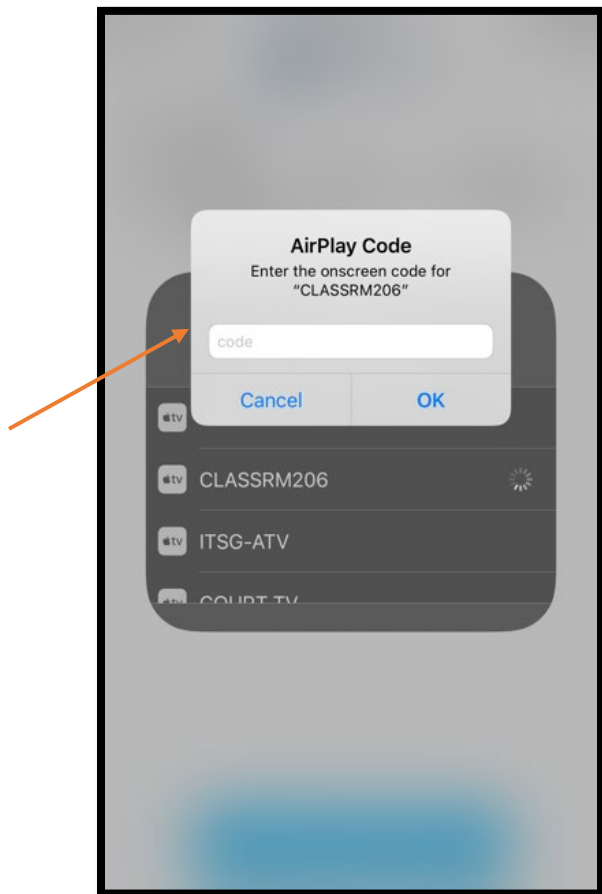
Click on "ScreenMirroring"

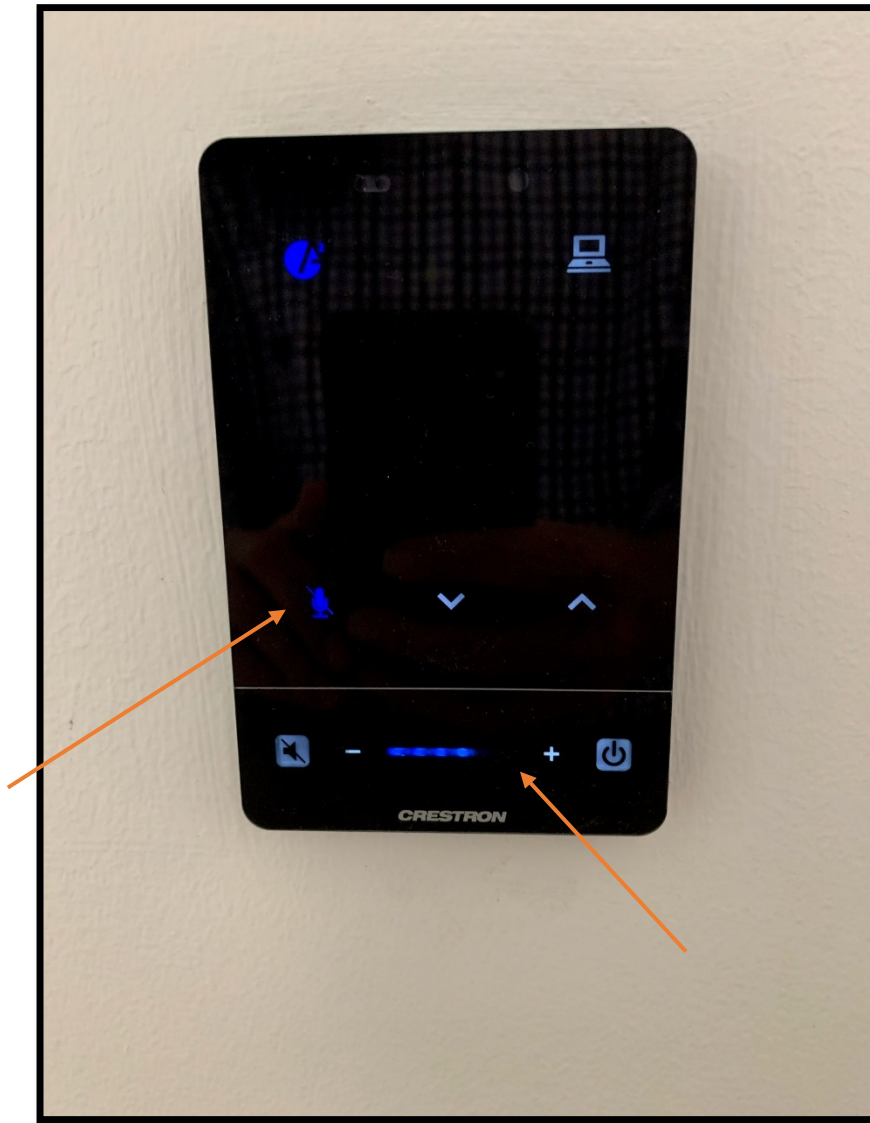

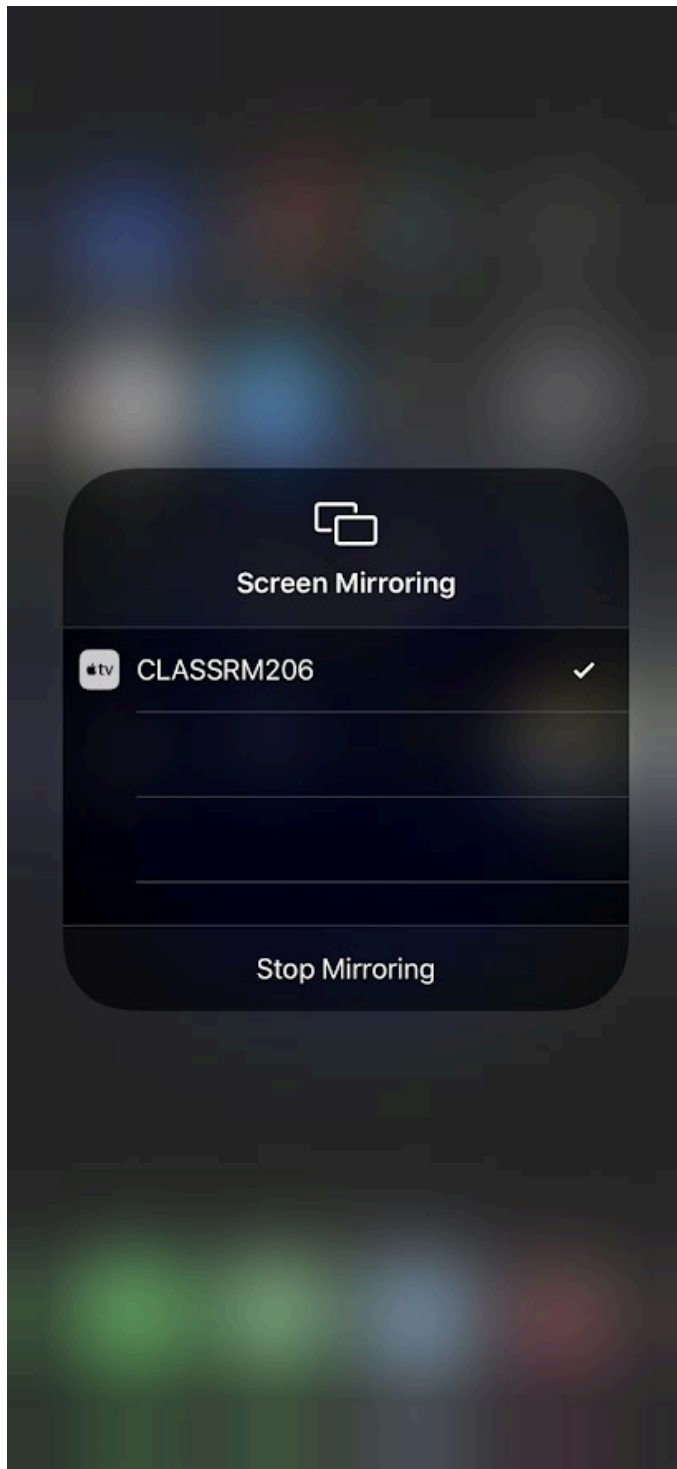


Stop Mirroring

Volume can be adjusted from the Crestron touch panel as well. The classrooms have separate controls for mic and device volume.



To disconnect go back to Control Center by swiping down from the upper right corner. Select Screen Mirroring and tap Stop Mirroring.
