

Faculty, Staff & Student Guide for Connecting Chromebooks to Campus Wireless

1. Select **UNA Start Here** in your list of available wireless networks.
2. When your device shows it is connected to “UNA Start Here,” open Chrome and attempt to browse to a website.
3. At the welcome page, select **Employee/Student**.

Employee/Student

Employees/Students with valid credentials will be moved to a secure wireless network and will receive full network access. In order to properly and securely access all necessary resources, all employees and students needing wireless access should utilize this network.


New Guest

Guests will receive restricted Internet-only network access as some on campus resources will not be available from the guest wireless network. Also, the guest network's speeds are limited in order to accommodate the main campus network and the broadest number of possible users.


Returning Guest

Login to your existing guest account or request your password to be resent.


4. Click "Install".




5. Select Add.




6. Enter your **UNAPortal Username and Password** and click “Download”.




7. After you click Download, a file named “SecureW2.onc” is downloaded and another tab opens in Chrome. **Click the tab, then click “Choose File.”**




8. From Downloads select the “SecureW2.onc” file, then click **Open**.




9. After clicking open, you will need to **manually select** “UNA WiFi” from the available networks. IF after selecting “UNA WiFi” you get another window with settings, go ahead and click “Connect” and you’ll be connected and able to surf.





10. You should now be connected to UNA WiFi but need to clear out settings saved for UNA Start Here. Navigate to Settings, click on **Wi-Fi Network** and click **“Preferred Networks...”**



11. Click the X next to “UNA Start Here” to remove it from the list and click **Done**.
