

- I. This Constitutional Amendment shall be known and cited as the DIA duties amendment.
- II. The purpose of this bill is to add to Article VI, Section 7 of the constitution in order to better define the position of the Diversity and Inclusion Advocate.
- III. Article VI, Section 7 currently reads:
The duties of the Diversity & Inclusion Advocate shall be as follows:
 - A. Communicate with University Departments and Registered Student Organizations to guarantee equitable opportunity for all students.
 - B. Responsible for promoting a safe and welcoming campus for all students at the University of North Alabama.
- IV. Article VI, Section 7 now shall read:
The duties of the Diversity & Inclusion Advocate shall be as follows:
 - A. Communicate with University Departments and Registered Student Organizations to guarantee equitable opportunity for all students.
 - B. Responsible for promoting a safe and welcoming campus for all students at the University of North Alabama.
 - C. Oversee the SGA RSO outreach initiatives.
 - D. Communicate with the Division of Student Affairs concerning Local, State, and National legislation that may affect the campus community.
 - E. Work with the chair of the Student Welfare Committee in order to orchestrate an event for the campus community.
- V. This bill will become law upon the ratification by majority (2/3) vote of the University of North Alabama Student Government Association Senate, approval by the Student Government Association President and Vice-President, and the subsequent approval of the student body by a referendum vote.
